Central Bedfordshire Council are creating a network of free 'Warm Spaces' across Central Bedfordshire where everyone is welcome. These Warm Spaces can be found in libraries, leisure centres and community venues.

Currently in Dunstable, there are 6 Warm Spaces available.

- ◆ Info point for saving energy and managing your money
- ◆ A chance to socialise and meet up with friends

**The Mayfield Centre-** Mayfield Road, Downside, LU5 4AP. Open Wednesday's and Tuesday's from 10:00am to 13:00pm.

Services available:

- ◆ Homemade soup provided every week
- ◆ Tea, coffee, and biscuits
- ◆ Free money-saving tips and benefits advice

**Vera Chilly Social Care-** St Mary's Catholic Church, 82 West Street. Open Tuesday's from 11:30am to 14:30pm

Services available:

- ◆ Socialising with friends and meeting new friends
- ◆ Socket for charging phones
- ◆ One-to-one support
- ◆ Arts and crafts
- ◆ Free advice and signposting to relevant services
- ◆ Information about community services, welfare benefits, energy savings, Covid-19 Vaccination, Flu vaccines and other relevant information.
- ◆ Hot drinks
- ◆ Biscuits, cupcakes, sandwiches including vegetarian options, fruits.
- ◆ Soup and roll, pies, and hot food (TBC)

This is a drop-in service, no booking required. People can attend with their own drinks and snacks.



## Dunstable Foodbank

The Trussell Trust supports communities and churches to open foodbanks across the UK. As a result, there are 3 foodbanks in the local area.

**New Life Church, Dunstable-** Open on Tuesday between 14:00- 16:00pm and Wednesday between 10:00am- 12:00pm.

**The Way, Christ Church, Dunstable-** Open on Tuesday between 14:30pm-16:30pm and Friday 12:30pm- 14:30pm.

**St Augustine's Church, Oakwood Avenue-** Open on Thursday between 09:30- 11:30am.

**Houghton Regis Baptist Church-** Open on Thursday between 13:30-15:30pm.



Dunstable Foodbanks supports residents in LU5 and LU6 postcodes only.

The Foodbanks work using a voucher referral system. A voucher can be issued by local agencies, such as the Citizens Advice, Salvation Army, Children Centre's, and Health Visitors.

## Childrens Crisis Centre Fund

Central Bedfordshire Council have set up a new Crisis Fund to support families with household bills and payments, and other items, throughout the winter and into 2023. There is £45,000 of funding available through the Crisis Fund, which will be administered through nine Children's Centres.

These centres are located in Sandy, Shefford, Stotfold, Flitwick, Leighton Buzzard, with two in Dunstable and two in Houghton Regis - who already work with over 4,700 families.

### What is the funding for?

Funding will be available from December 2022, with vouchers available to primarily cover household bills and payments.

Emergency support will also be available- for example, to replace an essential household appliance that is broken, like a fridge or washing machine, or to ensure children in the household have winter weather clothing.

### Who is eligible?

The council will be using the funding to support families already known to the Children's Centres who use our services. And our partners, including in health, housing, and education, will be able to refer families in need for extra support.

## Turn2us

Turn2us is a national charity that provides practical help to people who are struggling financially.

They offer support to individuals facing financial shocks, and together they challenge the systems and perceptions that cause financial insecurity.

They enable people to look for funds that offer grants or other types of help financially, as well as provide a benefit calculator to ensure people are receiving the right support to which they are entitled.
